Mr Evans,

I am unable to attend on the 26<sup>th</sup> November, as I have been listed for a Training Course on that day.

I am happy to respond, but have to say that I am extremely shocked to hear about the issues raised, and would like you to report back the following to the Chairman and the Parish Council:

I have scrutinized our Police systems from 1<sup>st</sup> September, 2014 up to the present day, and can find no reports at all of any suspicious vehicles in the area. There have been no reports/calls regarding, “ cars driving up and down the local roads in a suspicious manner”..... not one!

The only incidents that have been reported are the following:

On 29<sup>th</sup> September, a local resident reported a suspicious youth knocking on doors in the local area. Police promptly attended and there was no trace of the youth, no offences were committed.

On 14<sup>th</sup> October, a local resident reported a suspicious youth had knocked on his door, but this when he later returned home, and realized that his partner had bought several items from the Salesman! (I think there is a lesson to be learnt there)!

There are no current issues for the Police to take action on in the Poulton and Pulford areas.
