Mr Evans,

I am unable to attend on the 26th November, as I have been listed for a Training Course on that day.

I am happy to respond, but have to say that I am extremely shocked to hear about the issues raised, and would like you to report back the following to the Chairman and the Parish Council:

I have scrutinized our Police systems from 1st September, 2014 up to the present day, and can find no reports at all of any suspicious vehicles in the area. There have been no reports/calls regarding, “ cars driving up and down the local roads in a suspicious manner”..... not one!

The only incidents that have been reported are the following:

On 29th September, a local resident reported a suspicious youth knocking on doors in the local area. Police promptly attended and there was no trace of the youth, no offences were committed.

On 14th October, a local resident reported a suspicious youth had knocked on his door, but this when he later returned home, and realized that his partner had bought several items from the Salesman! (I think there is a lesson to be learnt there)!

There are no current issues for the Police to take action on in the Poulton and Pulford areas.
